**Use of School Facilities
Category of Users**

The user categories are defined as follows:

Category I

Activities directly related to the normal school district programs shall be permitted the use of the various school facilities with the established rental charges being reduced or waived by the school district. The school district will also reduce or waive the staff fees for such activities; except, however, the applicant may be required to pay for services above the normal cleaning duties. Groups and/or activities that are presently included in Category I include:

1. Teacher Association (organizational meetings).
2. Band Parents.
3. School-sponsored athletic, club, or booster normal activities (examples: banquets, regular meetings, fundraising activities).
4. Invitational athletic events sponsored by the booster clubs and/or athletic teams shall be charged for the service of all required personnel.
5. Junior Achievement.
6. Parent-Teacher groups.
7. County Commissioners (use as polling centers).
8. Faculty Recreation.
9. Or, as directed by the Board.

In recognition of the pupil benefit derived by student participation in P.I.A.A., Y.A.I.A.A., and other approved athletic associations, the Board will permit the use of the district athletic facilities for district and school playoffs, tournaments, and other related events.

Category II

Activities sponsored by recreational commissions for those municipalities within the Dallastown Area School District shall be permitted to use the various school facilities with the cost of the established rental rate being reduced by the school district. The school district may waive some of the staff fees. The various recreational commissions must pay a charge for services above the normal cleaning services. However, a minimum opening and closing fee will be charged for each use. The recreation

commissions shall supply the necessary insurance, with the insurance carriers supplying certificates of insurance to the School Board. Multiple uses of school facilities by booster clubs and other sports programs within the school district for youth are in this category.

Category III

Activities sponsored by those non-profit organizations that are chartered or established totally within the Dallastown Area School District and whose program shall provide civic, educational, or athletic benefits to participants, which shall consist of a minimum of seventy percent (70%) of Dallastown Area School District residents. The charge shall be fifty percent (50%) of the rental rate for these activities. In addition, the applicant shall pay all staff fees.

Category IV

Activities sponsored by those non-profit organizations not chartered or established totally within the Dallastown Area School District and providing civic, educational, or athletic benefits to a group of individuals, which do not consist of at least seventy percent (70%) of Dallastown Area School District residents. The charge shall be seventy-five percent (75%) of the rental rates for these activities. In addition, the applicant shall pay all staff fees.

Category V

Activities sponsored by county, district and state governmental/educational organizations, with which the school district is affiliated, may use various school facilities. The rental rate for such events will be reduced or waived according to the facility used, the benefit of the event to the school district and the reciprocity arrangements made by other affiliated schools. In addition, the applicant shall pay all staff fees.

Category VI

All users of school facilities that are not addressed by the previous five (5) categories shall be considered in Category VI. The rental charge for the use of school facilities by Category VI users shall be the full rental charge set forth on Exhibit B. In addition, the applicant shall pay all staff fees.

Rental Charge Adjustments

Rental charges applicable to each user may be adjusted pending the user's contribution to the maintenance, upkeep, or enhancement of the school facilities upon the prior approval and agreement of the school district. An adjustment to the rental charges may be granted by the district to an applicant based upon the nature and frequency of the applicant's use of school facilities, as well as the applicant's relationship to the district itself.
