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
## Welcome to the Dallastown Area School District!

To that end, we offer a full range of services to all EL students.

Upon completion of the Home Language Survey at registration, if you indicated that your child speaks another language at home, we are obligated by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to screen your student and place him/her accordingly. Screenings are conducted at one of our two EL buildings, either York Township Elementary or Ore Valley Elementary, in May during *Kindergarten Student Registration*. You will be required to schedule the screening appointment according to the following chart:

## **Kindergarten Screening Process**



When screening determines a student qualifies for EL services, it may necessitate a change in building assignment. Transportation is provided to and from the school regardless of the home building.
